TEXT ORDER denying without prejudice [75] Plaintiff's Consent Motion for Approval of Renewed Proposed Notice and Objection Procedure. Upon review of the settlement website and the proposed notices, the Court finds several typographical errors that must be cured before the notice can be approved. First, the case caption is incorrectly listed as *Teblum v. Physician Compassionate Care LLC d/b/a DocMJ*, Case No. 2:19-cv-00403-SPM-MRM (M.D. Fla.). (See e.g., Doc. 75-2 at 3; Doc. 75-3 at 3, 7; Doc. 75-4 at 2); *Teblum v. Physician Compassionate Care LLC d/b/a DocMJ Settlement Administrator*, <http://www.physiciancompassionatecaretcpsettlement.com> (last visited 2/24/2022); *Frequently Asked Questions, Teblum v. Physician Compassionate Care LLC d/b/a DocMJ Settlement Administrator*, <http://www.physiciancompassionatecaretcpsettlement.com/frequently-asked-questions.aspx> (last visited 2/24/2022). Because the parties have consented to the Undersigned's jurisdiction, the correct case caption is *Teblum v. Physician Compassionate Care LLC d/b/a DocMJ*, Case No. 2:19-cv-00403-MRM. Second, the explanation as to why the class members are receiving this notice states that the Court's Order denying without prejudice the Unopposed Motion for Final Approval of Class Settlement and Application for Service Award and Attorneys' Fees was entered 1/24/2021, as opposed to 1/24/2022. (Doc. 75-2 at 1; Doc. 75-3 at 3); *Frequently Asked Questions, Teblum v. Physician Compassionate Care LLC d/b/a DocMJ Settlement Administrator*,

So as to avoid any confusion on the part of the class members, the settlement website and notices must be revised to correct these errors. Accordingly, no later than 3/11/2022, the parties must renew their motion. The renewed motion must include (1) revised proposed notices that cure the typographical errors identified in this Order and (2) an affidavit by either Plaintiff's counsel or a representative of KCC Class Action Services LLC, averring that the same revisions have been made to each page of the settlement website.
